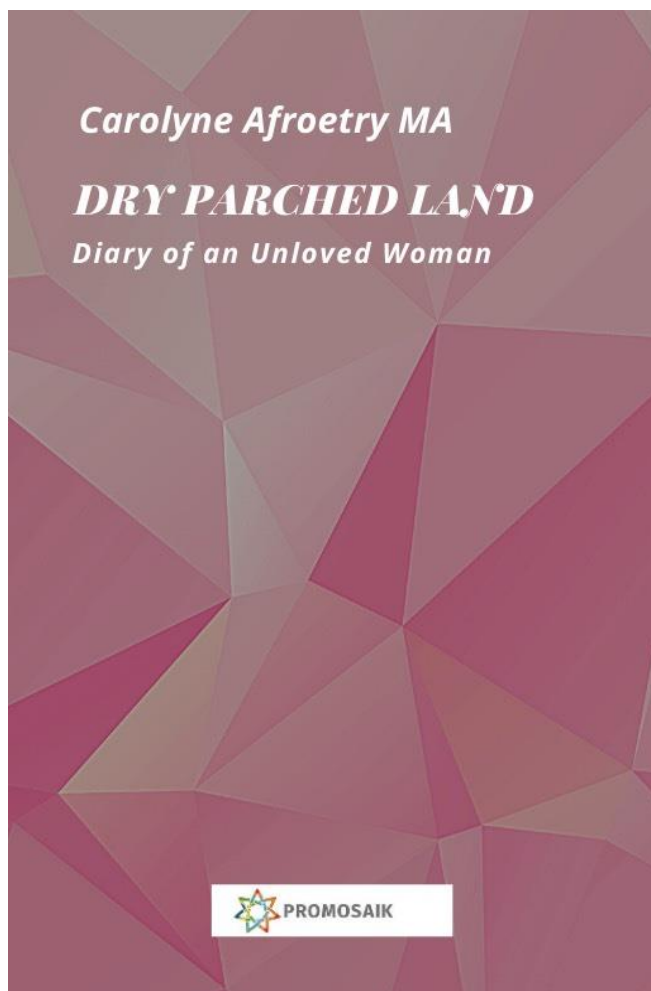


Dry Parched Land
